



Policy of Inclusion and Non-Violence

The WRC Croatia Rally Organizing Committee has adopted this Policy of Inclusion and Non-Violence with the aim of fostering an organizational and sports culture based on mutual respect and appreciation of individual differences.

We are committed to creating and maintaining an environment in which all our employees, partners, collaborators, and guests feel comfortable in their own skin, feel part of an event that is valuable for the sport and the society of the country, while enabling economic prosperity. Our commitment begins with showing mutual respect and supporting the diversity of ideas, experiences and perspectives coming from different genders, cultures, nations, ages, sexual orientations, and physical abilities – as all of this ultimately makes us a better and stronger organization.

Motorsport is a sport intended for everyone, regardless of their origin, background, or other characteristics. The WRC Croatia Rally Organizer is determined to grant access, secure maximum comfort, and provide a good time to everyone. To achieve this, the organizer asks all spectators to come to the event in a good mood and with good intentions so that they can enjoy the sport to the fullest and provide people around them with the most comfortable environment. The intention of the organizer is to actively promote sportsmanship, cooperation, inclusion, acceptance of diversity and equality, while respecting the personal dignity of each individual.

The WRC Croatia Rally Organizer distances itself from the unwanted conduct of all those attendees who pose a threat to the personal integrity of visitors and all persons involved in the organization of the event and deplores in the strongest terms all forms of discrimination, violence, and harassment.
